Breakfast (Frühstück) is one of the most important meals of the day in Germany and traditionally consists of a warm beverage and cereal or fresh bread with either jam, chocolate spread or cheese. Snacking in Germany is quite popular with a mid-morning snack eaten before it's time for lunch (Mittagessen). Usually after lunch some cake is enjoyed as an afternoon snack.

Dinner (Abendessen) in Germany is normally eaten between 6pm and 8pm, which is slightly earlier than other European countries such as Spain and Italy.

A schnitzel is a thin slice of meat (or vegetarian alternative, like cheese) fried in fat and can be made from veal, pork, chicken or

Steamed, then fried pork sausage (Bratwurst) cut into bite-sized chunks and seasoned with curry ketchup, traditionally served with french fries

Kartoffelpuffer

Potatoes that are finely grated raw, mixed with egg, onion and flour and then fried. They have a crispy exterior and soft interior and can be served as either sweet or savoury

A pretzel, made from dough and shaped like a knot with salt usually
