Italian breakfasts (prima colazione) are usually quite small and light consisting of a coffee and small pastry. Lunch (pranzo) is normally the largest and most filling meal of the day with a number of courses.

Dinner (cena) is usually divided into a number of courses including antipasti (appetizers), primi (first course - pasta / rice) and secondi (second course - meat / fish) with contorni (sides) and dolci (dessert) to finish.

Traditionally made from durum wheat, water or eggs. It is formed into different shapes and then cooked. It is used in many popular dishes include carbonara, spaghetti bolognese and lasagne

An antipasto dish consisting of grilled bread rubbed with garlic and topped with olive oil and salt. Variations may include toppings of tomatoes, vegetables, beans, cured meat, or cheese.

A northern Italian rice dish cooked with broth. The broth can be derived from meat, fish, or vegetables. Many types of risotto contain butter, onion, white wine, and parmesan cheese.

Flat oven-baked Italian bread similar in style and texture to pizza dough. It can be used as a side dish, an appetizer, a snack or for a

Gelato is an authentic Italian dessert. The main difference between gelato and ice-cream is the ingredients used and how it is made. Gelato uses more milk than cream and it tends to not use any eggs.
