Lithuanian breakfast (pusryčiai) is always served with a cup of tea or coffee and a white bread sandwich with butter and smoked or cooked sausage or various types of porridge.

Lunch (pietūs) is the most filling meal of the day usually served with a plate of soup and a main dish, mostly consisting of meat and potatoes.

For dinner (vakrienė) a light meal is served. For example, dairy soups, potato salads or potato pancakes are the most favoured meals. However, big dinners are served during celebrations such as Christmas Eve.



A cold summer soup with beets and milk kefir or sour milk, made with cooked or pickled shredded beets and various other chopped vegetables & herbs such as cucumber, dill, or green onions.

Cepelinai

A traditional Lithuanian dish made from grated and riced potatoes and stuffed with ground meat or dry curd cheese or mushrooms.

A traditional Samogitian (northwestern region of Lithuania) dish made from sour cream, curdled milk and butter with spices.

Kūčiukai/šližikai

Small, slightly sweet pastries made from leavened dough and poppy seeds eaten separately or with poppyseed milk. This is a traditional Kūčios (Christmas Eve) dish.


